

The Donor Alliance Foundation's mission is to build partnerships and break down barriers to influence change that will positively affect the donation and transplant community.

Research Program Area

Created in December 1993 as a nonprofit 501c3 and re-established in August 2017, it operates exclusively for charitable, scientific and educational purposes as a supporting organization to Donor Alliance.

The Donor Alliance Foundation funds education, family assistance and research efforts of nonprofit organizations working in the field of organ and tissue donation and transplantation in Colorado and Wyoming.

Research

Grants will include:

- › Clinical and social research grants to small, ongoing research projects in the field of donation and transplantation

Grantmaking Criteria

Projects should:

- › Align with The Donor Alliance Foundation's mission to build partnerships, break down barriers and positively affect the donation and transplant community
- › Be located Colorado or Wyoming
- › Be submitted from nonprofit organizations (individuals are not qualified to apply)
- › Demonstrate positive impact and measurable outcomes. Make a difference in the community, not just for the organizations applying

Research Program Specific Grant Criteria

Applicants should:

- › Submit additional narrative along with the online application including an executive summary explaining their work/project, the purpose of the study, proposed intervention and deliverables. It will be important to make a case for how this grant will help secure long-term funding
- › Applications may also be submitted for social research funding and will require similar additional documentation about the project

The Foundation will award up to \$175,000 during the first grant cycle from September 1, 2018 - August 31, 2019.

- ✓ Nonprofit community health-serving organizations
- ✓ Colorado and Wyoming hospitals
- ✓ Universities and medical schools
- ✓ Foundations
- ✓ Transplant centers
- ✓ Nonprofit organizations doing work in donation and transplantation

- 1 Applications due by 5 p.m. MDT on Monday, July 16, 2018
- 2 Potential site visits between July 23 - August 17, 2018
- 3 All applicants notified in August 2018
