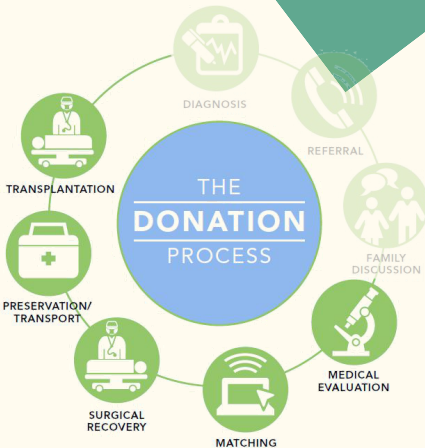

Organ donation is an incredibly rare and meaningful opportunity. Over 108,000 people await the gift of life across the country; your role as a hospital partner is crucial to ensuring the gift reaches those who wait.



# CONVERSATION TOUCHPOINTS

After a referral has been made to Donor Alliance, the process and timing of donation conversations is vital to preserve the option of donation.



## CLINICAL TRIGGERS MET

Call within 1 hour of a vented patient meeting clinical triggers.



## MONITOR & FOLLOW REFERRAL

It is critical that the opportunity for donation is presented by Donor Alliance within the appropriate timing and circumstances.

Donor Alliance staff will partner with the care team to determine the most appropriate way to share donation information.

Families often share that they wish the discussion had occurred earlier.

**44%**

of families who decline Donation after Circulatory Death cite the timing of the conversation and donation process.

Please be aware of cues suggesting the family is transitioning to end of life discussions or decision-making.
