WHEREAS, Wyoming has the nation's 4th highest-performing state donor registry with 61% of driver license/ID card applicants signing up to be organ and tissue donors - a decision that reflects deep commitment to helping their neighbor; and

WHEREAS, one donor can save up to eight lives through organ donation and can save and heal more than 75 lives through tissue donation; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. officially surpassed 40,000 transplants in one year in 2021 during a pandemic, a historic first for the nation which is a testament to the lifesaving work being done each day by Donor Alliance in Wyoming and all organ procurement organizations across America; and

WHEREAS, around 1,500 people continue to wait in our region for a lifesaving organ transplant and thousands more need healing tissue and corneal transplants in order to lead full lives and return to their families, careers and communities; and

NOW THEREFORE, I, MARK GORDON, Governor of the State of Wyoming, do hereby proclaim April 22, 2022 as

in Wyoming.
