## NATIONAL DONATE LIFE MONTH

## **April 2023**

**WHEREAS,** this April 2023 is 20<sup>th</sup> National Donate Life Month with a goal to raise

awareness about organ, eye and tissue donation, encourage Americans to register as donors and honor those that have saved lives

through the gift of donation; and

**WHEREAS,** Colorado has the nation's highest-performing state donor registry with

67% of driver license/ID card applicants signing up to be organ and tissue donors—a decision that reflects deep commitment to one

another and confirms that there is good inside all of us; and

WHEREAS, One donor can save up to 8 lives through organ donation and save

and heal more than 75 lives through tissue donation; and

WHEREAS, A record 278 heroic organ donors saved 740 lives in 2022, a 29%

increase from 2021; and Donor Alliance recovered tissue for transplant from 1,911 heroic tissue donors saving and healing with nearly 144,000

tissue grafts; and

**WHEREAS,** there are nearly 1,500 people waiting for a lifesaving organ transplant

in Colorado and Wyoming. Of those waiting, nearly 1,200 are waiting for a kidney—the organ most in need—and nearly 120 are waiting for

a liver; and

WHEREAS, The U.S. has officially has achieved its 1 millionth organ transplant,

including the more than 42,800 organ transplants performed in 2022, another historic first for the nation which is a testament to the lifesaving work being done day by Donor Alliance and all organ

procurement organizations across America; and

**WHEREAS,** Donor Alliance's Donor Service Area serves 6.3 million residents and

covers 184,151 square miles - this includes all of Colorado and most of

Wyoming.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tom Strand, President of the Colorado Springs City Council, do
